- 2. The materials for the system shall be delivered to the jobsite in sealed containers identified by the manufacturer's name product name and shelf life.
- 3. Installation of AVM System 700 shall be in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, a copy of which shall be available at each jobsite.
- 4. Surfaces to be covered shall be sound, clean and free of laitance, oil, wax or grease. Cement substrates shall be troweled semi smooth or finished with light broom surface texture.

5 After the membrane has cured, carefully inspect the surface for bubbles blotches, clumps

or other imperfections at the fabric joints or within the field areas.

6. The coating system shall not be applied at temperatures below 40°F
